THE DIVINE NAME OF GOD

God told Moses

‘Ehye Asher Ehye’ (אֶהְיֶה אֲשֶׁר אֶהְיֶה)

or simply ‘Ehye’ (אֶהְיֶה).

In most English Bibles this name is translated as,

“I Am Who I Am” or

simply “I Am.” (Exodus 3:14).

In Exodus 3:15 (CJB): God said further to Moshe, "Say this to the people of Isra'el: 'Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh (ADONAI), the God of your fathers, the God of Avraham, the God of Yitz'chak and the God of Ya'akov, has sent me to you.' This is my name forever; this is how I am to be remembered generation after generation.

This name is technically known as the Tetragrammaton made up of four consonants. Since the original Hebrew text did not use vowels, it is difficult to determine the correct pronunciation.

God said, “Do not take my name in vain.” He did not say, “Do not take my name at all.”

Pious Jews considered it so holy that they would not pronounce the divine name. Today, nobody knows how to pronounce God’s name: YHWH. People put so much emphasis on the second part of the commandment “in vain” that they missed out the beauty and joy of taking His name!

OMISSION OF GOD'S NAME IN BIBLE

Psalms 44:20-21, "If we have forgotten the name of our God or stretched out our hands to a strange God would not God discover this?"

In most English Bibles the word **YHVH** or **YHWH** has been replaced by **LORD** and God's name **YHWH** has been placed as a footnote. There are several reasons for it.

One being, the Jewish tradition of the ineffable name doctrine that considered it too holy to be uttered!

13 Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" 14 And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'" 15 God also said to Moses, "Say this to the people of Israel, 'The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you'; this is my name for ever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations." 16 Go and gather the elders of Israel together, and say to them, "The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, has appeared to me, saying, 'I have observed you and what has been done to you in Egypt; 17 and I promise that I will bring you up out of the affliction of Egypt into the land of Canaan, and will say to you, "What is the name of the LORD?"' 18 And he said, "Cast it on the ground." 19 So he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent; and Moses fled from it. 20 But the LORD said to Moses, "Put out your hand, and take it by the tail"—so he put out his hand and caught it, and it became a rod in his hand— 21 that they may believe that the LORD, the God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has appeared to you." 22 Again, the LORD said to him, "Put your hand into your bosom." And he put his hand into his bosom; and when he took it out, behold, his hand was leprous, as white as snow. 23 Then God said, "Put your hand back into your bosom." So he put his hand back into his bosom; and when he took it out, behold, it was restored like the rest of his flesh. 24 "If they will not believe you," God said, "or heed the first sign, they may believe the latter sign. 25 If they will not believe even

This was later adopted by Christians (refer references 1 & 2). One of the gravest errors ever committed is the omission of God's most holy name that appears more than 6800 times (according to Bible scholars) in the original Hebrew Scriptures known as Old Testament.

Nothing could be more sacrilegious than relegating the name that should occupy the most prominent place in the Bible to a footnote on just one page!

Man has removed God's distinctive and personal name from His own Book and replaced it with a generic name such as Lord!

God's name should be taken with utmost love and reverence. The fear of His name is to ensure that nobody profanes or dishonors His divine name.

His holy name alone is enough to work wonders in your life!

GOD LEFT HIS NAME & WORD IN OUR DNA

Proverbs 25:2, "It is the glory of God to conceal things, but the glory of kings is to search things out."

Man may have removed God's most divine name: **YHWH** from the Bible. But God is way ahead of man. His ways and thoughts are higher than man. Science has discovered that God has imprinted His name in our cells, in our genes – a place within us where nobody can replace His holy name.

DNA is a code for amino acids that are the building blocks of protein, which are the workers of our cell. Contained in our DNA are segments called genes. Each gene is an instruction for making a protein.

These genes are written in a specific language. Only four letters are used: T, C, A, G that stand for four types of biochemical: Thymine, Cytosine, Adenine, and Guanine. When you interpret the human genome as its amino acid building blocks, you get a vast sequence of letters such as AAAGTCTGAC which is then translated.

According to the *The YHWH Code* by Rabbi Dani'el Rendelman of Emet Ministries, when the four elements of human DNA are converted into letters, and based on their matching atomic mass values hydrogen becomes the Hebrew letter Yod (Y), nitrogen becomes Hey (H), oxygen becomes Wav (V or W), and carbon becomes

Gimel (G). When carbon is replaced with nitrogen, they form the tetragrammton **YHWH**.

In the book, *The God Code*, author Gregg Braden reveals that every human being has the name of God embedded in his or her DNA. He explains how the first three letters stand for God's name **YHW** which represents the invisible form of the Creator since all three (hydrogen, nitrogen and oxygen) are invisible gases. The last element carbon G that stands for man is what gives us a tangible face and form.

Neil Whitehead, a retired research scientist, has published amazing research findings on his website: www.godindna.nz. He discovered that abbreviations of the 14 most common names of God found in Hebrew Scriptures appeared about 500,000 times in each human cell - i.e., trillions of times (500,000 x 10 trillion) in the human body.

"One of the most common four letter words in the genes was **YHWH**, the full name of God; it appeared 500 times in each cell. Its common abbreviation, **YH**, appeared 35,000 times. We appear to be saturated with the names of God - or at least his signature," writes Whitehead on his website.
